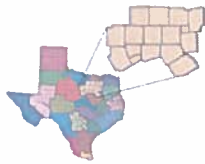

October 2016 Data

Total Nonagricultural Wage and Salary employment rose for the seventh consecutive month with 13,700 jobs added in October. Mirroring this movement was the Service Providing sector with 13,900 positions added over the month, while the Goods Producing sector contrasted with a loss of 200 jobs. Since January, Total Nonfarm employment rose by 139,000 jobs and outperformed the pace set the prior year when 118,700 positions were added, but was down from a 2014 level shift of 316,400 positions added over the same time frame. Annually, Total Nonagricultural employment rose for the 78th consecutive month with a gain of 207,500 jobs since October 2015; however, the annual growth rate declined 0.1 percentage points from September 2016 to reach 1.7 percent in October

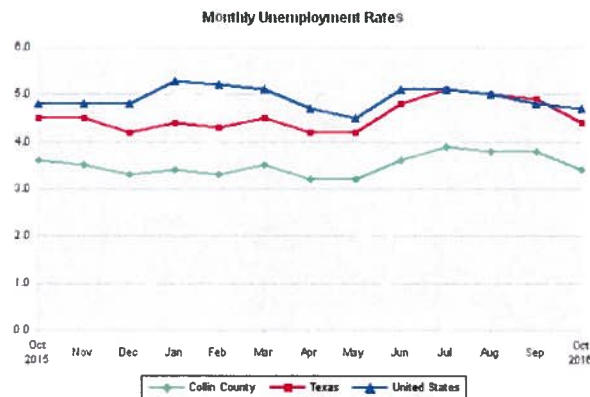

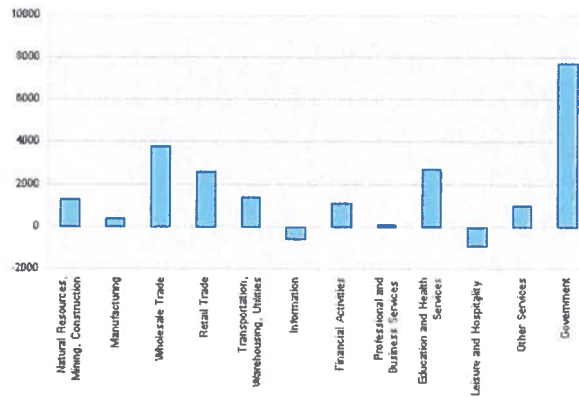
